This will include a discussion of: placement stability and quality of care; education; leaving care later; and being supported on pathways to adulthood. In respect of each of these four themes the presentation will identify the challenges faced by services and the implications for policy and practice. By reference to three main 'outcome groups'-those who successfully move on from care, those who survive and those who struggle, it will be suggested that responding to these policy and practice challenges provides a context for promoting the individual agency and resilience of young people.
